Sunday, September 3

- 1 p.m. Bring the whole family to watch as magician and illusionist, <u>Joe Holiday</u>, puts on an incredible fun-filled family magic show. Holiday is an expert at keeping the kids laughing and the adults amazed. Individuals of all ages are welcome at this show.
- **8 p.m.** Chicago-based Magician, <u>Kayla Drescher</u> rounds out the weekend with her performance, "Magic in Heels," which incorporates expert sleight-of-hand, comedy, entertaining stories and lots of audience participation. This show is for individuals ages 15 and older.
